

DRIVER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

To add the Driver Education endorsement to either a secondary or specialist teaching certificate, specific course work is required by the State of Illinois Board of Education. Those courses are listed below and include a minimum of **16 credit hours**.

Tuition Costs per credit hour:

Summer and Immersion	\$320.00
Spring and Fall	\$860.00

May Immersion begins May 19th and goes until June 4th, 2010. Early registration for Summer term begins April 14th, 2010. Summer semester begins on June 7 and ends on July 30, 2010.

Upon completion of the Driver Education course work:

Submit your transcripts to your respective Regional Office of Education for evaluation of endorsement requirements. Most likely, they will send your transcript into the state for evaluation to determine your Driver Education Certification. If you are missing any credits toward the certification, the Regional Office will let you know.

You may take this endorsement information to the Regional Office in advance of your registration for courses at Millikin University to verify the courses needed to obtain the Driver Education endorsement.
