

transferring to millikin checklist

Here are the steps you need to complete for a seamless transition from there to here. You can check them off as you go.

- Visit the Campus.** It's the best way to experience our people, programs and services. Walk along our beautiful campus and see yourself here. Choose from one of our convenient Open Houses, or schedule a day that works best for you. Schedule your visit online at www.millikin.edu/visit.
- Apply for Admission.** There's no application fee, no essay to complete. Complete the application and return it to our Office of Admission. Submit your official high school and college transcripts from every school you've attended. We also require a recommendation from a current or former instructor.

The best time to apply is immediately after you have completed a minimum of 12 semester hours at your previous college. Please allow three weeks for processing after all documents have been sent.
- Apply for Financial Aid.** File the Free Application for Federal Student Assistance (FAFSA) or your renewal papers as soon as possible after January 1 each year. Millikin's federal code is 001724. Apply online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. For more information, a list of our costs, scholarship opportunities, etc., go to www.millikin.edu/financialaid.
- Register for Classes.** Your mission is to complete the application and admission process in a timely manner, preparing you for early registration. Your \$150 advanced tuition deposit must be paid prior to registration.
- Complete your Housing Application.** All students are required to live on campus through junior year. This may include The Woods at Millikin.
- Attend Transfer Orientation.**
