2007-2008 Success Report Facts:

- ❑ The “Comprehensive Success Rate” is 99%. This includes a combination of graduates who are “Professionally Employed” (65%), “Continuing Education” (24%) and “Underemployed” (11%).
- ❑ The “Professional Success Rate” is 89%. This includes a combination of graduates who are “Professionally Employed” (65%) and “Continuing Education” (24%).
- ❑ Statistics are based on degrees and/or majors earned, not on graduates. 488 degrees and/or majors were earned. 47 students earned either double majors or double degrees.
- ❑ Graduate information was obtained from a variety of sources (graduates, family members, faculty, staff, Facebook) for 414 degrees and/or majors, which is 85% of 2007-2008 graduates.
- ❑ 7 graduates responding to the 2008 Success Report survey were not actively seeking employment or continuing their education after graduation and are not included in calculations. Thus, calculations are based on 407 degrees and/or majors. It should be noted that six of these graduates reported that they are currently applying to graduate school and are waiting to be accepted.
- ❑ Percentages may not add up to 100% due to rounding.
- ❑ Professional Employment is down 10% from last year. Continuing Education is up 5% from last year. Underemployment is up 6% from last year, and Unemployment is the same at just under 1%. The overall Comprehensive Success Rate is down slightly from 99.6% to 99%, and Professional Success is down 5% from 94% to 89%.
- ❑ 28 disciplines reported a 100% Professional Success Rate. 47 disciplines reported a 100% Comprehensive Success Rate
- ❑ 11 respondents reported being Professionally Employed and Continuing Education. 5 of these individuals are counted in the Continuing Education category because they are enrolled in school on a full-time basis. 6 of these individuals are counted in the Professional Employment category because they are enrolled in school on a part-time basis.
