Students will select between additional foreign language or science hours depending on whether they choose the Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science option.

* These courses are offered on an every other year basis.

** For students in the honors program, university studies courses are replaced with specific honors course requirements. Consult the bulletin for a list of these requirements.

*** Historical Studies and Literature may double dip with certain sections of some courses (e.g. honors seminars, IN250, IN350, etc.).
